PSA CAR Opens National ID Registration at Tiongsan Supermarket in La Trinidad

Baguio City - The Philippine Statistics Authority - Cordillera Administrative Region (PSA-CAR), continues to bring essential government services closer to the public by opening a National ID registration site at Tiongsan Supermarket in La Trinidad, Benguet. The registration center, situated within one of the most frequented shopping destinations in the province, will remain open until June 30, 2025, and is accepting registrants of all ages.

This effort is part of PSA CAR's ongoing mission to make the National ID more accessible to communities throughout the region. By situating the registration area in a well-known and central location, the agency aims to encourage broader participation from residents of La Trinidad and those from nearby towns. Tiongsan Supermarket serves as a commercial hub not only for La Trinidad but also for surrounding municipalities such as Sablan, Tublay, and Itogon. Its location offers easy access to public transportation and is near key establishments like banks, schools, and markets. This makes it a practical choice for people from different walks of life, including students, professionals, business owners, senior citizens, and daily wage earners. All Filipino citizens and resident aliens are eligible to register. For children or minors, a parent or legal guardian must accompany them. Registrants are advised to bring one valid government-issued ID or supporting documents for identity verification. The entire registration process is free of charge.



PSA CAR registration team is available on-site during mall hours and is ready to guide applicants through each step of the process. While walk-ins are welcome, early arrival is encouraged to avoid long queues.

The National ID aims to provide every Filipino and resident alien with a single, reliable, and government-recognized proof of identity. The system is designed to simplify transactions with both public and private institutions, reduce the need for multiple IDs, and improve access to services such as banking, education, healthcare, social protection, and employment opportunities. The National ID program also plays a key role in the government's digital transformation goals. It supports more efficient and transparent service delivery and helps ensure that underserved communities are included in the country's development efforts. Establishing this registration site at Tiongsan Supermarket reflects PSA CAR's commitment to making public services more responsive to the needs of local communities. Working in partnership with commercial establishments allows the agency to offer more convenient options for the public to register.

PSA CAR encourages all unregistered residents of La Trinidad and neighboring areas to take advantage of this opportunity. Registering for the National ID is a simple step that brings long-term benefits, including faster access to essential services and a more secure form of Identification.
