## 2025 2ND QUARTER REGISTERED BIRTHS IN KALINGA

Date of Release: 31 July 2025 Reference No. 25CAR32-922

The number of registered births in the province of Kalinga for the second quarter of 2025 summed up to 1,166. It is lesser by 55 compared to first quarter with 1,221. The City of Tabuk has the highest birth registered with 890 or 76.25 percent of the total registered births. The Municipality of Tanudan recorded the least number of registered births with 7 births followed by the municipality of Pasil with 17 registered births.




The month of May recorded the highest number of registered births with 408 in the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter of 2025 followed by June with 398 and the least was April with 360 registered births.

Figure 2. Percentage Distribution of Live Births by Municipality: Kalinga, 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2025





More than three-fourths or 76.33 percent of the total number of registered births in Kalinga for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2025 were from City of Tabuk. The remaining 23.67 percent came from the seven municipalities of the province. Tanudan have the least with 0.60 percent of the total number of registered live births in Kalinga.

In the province, almost two-thirds (65.52 percent) of the babies born were registered on time (764) while 34.48 percent (402) registered late.

In April 2025, there were more registered timely than late with 228 out of 360 registered. Tabuk City and Rizal have higher number of registered timely than late with 209 and 9 respectively. The municipalities of Lubuagan, Pasil, Pinukpuk, Tanudan and Tinglayan have higher number of registered late than timely. Pasil and Tanudan have not recorded timely registration.
