The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) - Kalinga, in collaboration with the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Pinukpuk, proudly announces the successful completion of the 2022 Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Data Turnover Ceremony to the Municipality of Pinukpuk through Chief Statistical Specialist (CSS) Maribel M. Dalayday, together with Senior Statistical Specialist (SrsSS) Bonifacio G. Calizar Jr.,
