The Philippine Statistics Authority-Benguet proudly participated in the 35th National Statistics Month (NSM) celebration, themed "Advancing Data and Statistics Through Digital Transformation: A Road to an Empowered Nation," as mandated by Presidential Proclamation No. 647, which declares October of every year as National Statistics Month, issued by former President Corazon C. Aquino.

To commemorate NSM, the Provincial Statistical Office of Benguet organized a motorcade on October 3, 2024.
