Santa Marcela, Apayao – The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Provincial Statistical Office (PSO) of Apayao successfully turned over the 2022 Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) data to the Municipal Local Government Unit (MLGU) of Santa Marcela, Apayao during a ceremonial turnover on January 11, 2024 at the EKB Clubhouse, Santa Marcela, Apayao.

The activity is a significant milestone for the municipality as they lead the conduct of the said census in partnership with the PSA. Mayor Evelyn B.
