21 February 2025 – PSA Provincial Statistical Office' personnel conducted their 2nd gift giving activity for 2025 at Upper Atok Elementary School, Upper Atok barangay, a remote area in the municipality of Flora, Apayao. There were 77 learners from Kinder to Grade 6 who were served small gifts of school supplies with funds provided by the Provincial Government of Apayao thru PSA-Apayao.
