HIGHLIGHTS OF THE REGISTERED VITAL EVENTS BONTOC: 2022

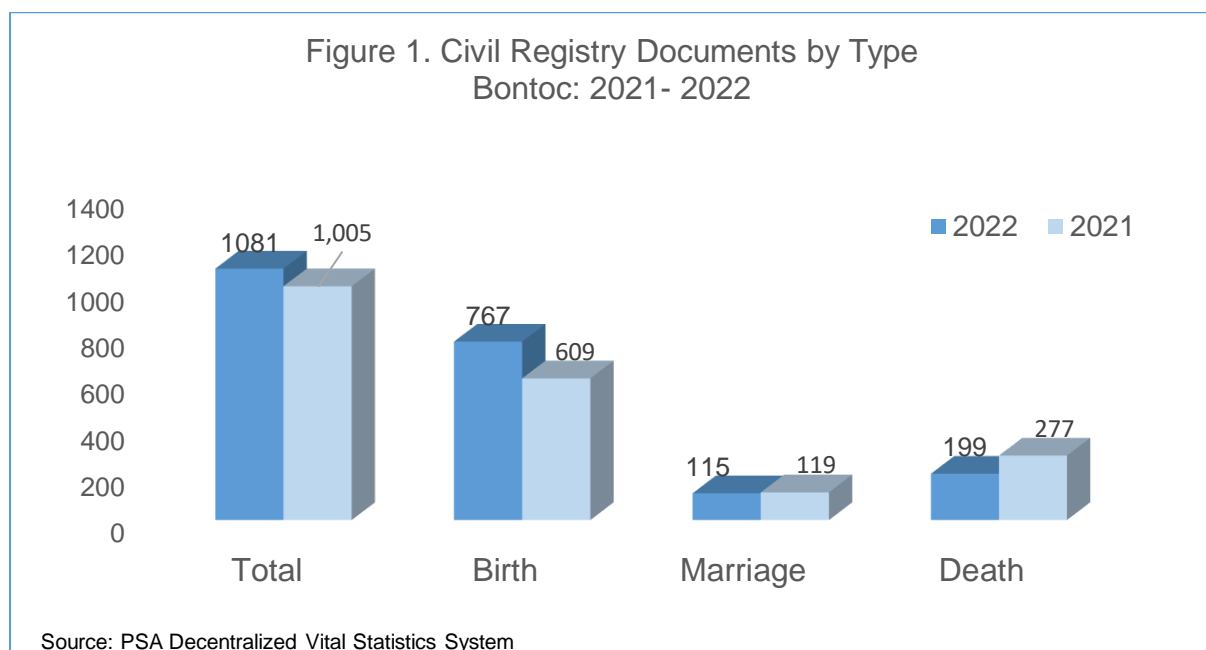
This Special Release presents data on birth, marriage and death certificates registered in the Local Civil Registry Office of Bontoc for 2021 and 2022 and forwarded to the Office of the Civil Registrar General. Data were tabulated from the DVSS. Thus, statistics presented here is preliminary.

About 7 in Every 10 Civil Registry Documents in Bontoc are Births

In 2022, the municipality of Bontoc accumulated a total of 1,081 civil registry documents which was 7.56 percent higher compared to the 1,005 registry documents listed in 2021. As expected, birth took the bulk of the documents with 767 registered births taking 70.95 percent of the total registry documents in the municipality. This means that about 7 in every 10 documents were births. This was 25.94 percent increase from its births in 2021 at 609.

Meanwhile, 2022 registered marriages in the municipality at 115 had 3.36 percent decrease from the 2021 data at 119 marriages. This data also took 10.64 percent of the total registry documents in Bontoc.

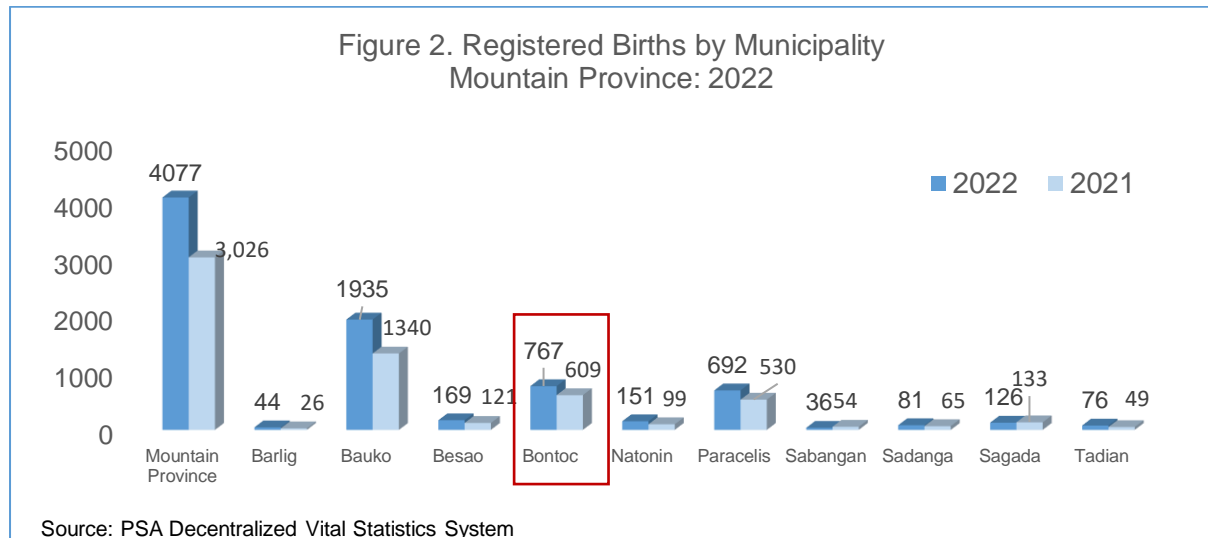
Recorded deaths of 199 decreased by 28.16 percent compared to the previous year with 277 recorded deaths.



About Two in Every Ten Births in Mountain Province are Registered in Bontoc

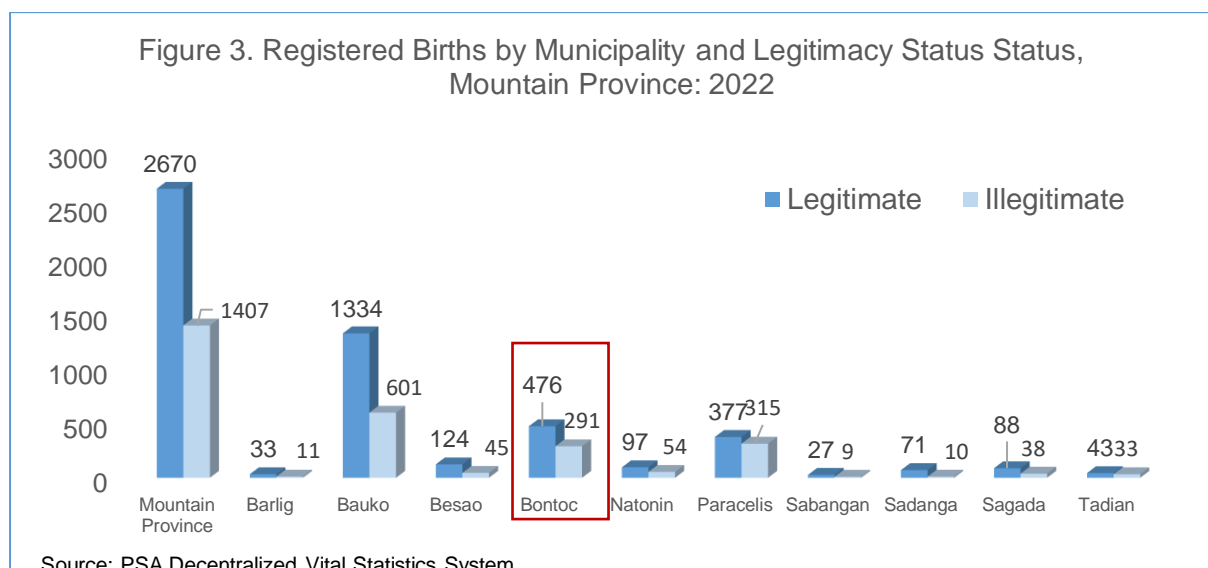
The municipality of Bontoc registered a total of 767 births in 2022. It had 18.81 percent share to the total births listed in the province at 4,077 births. This translates to about 2 in every 10 births in the province were from this municipality.

In 2021, Bontoc contributed 20.13 percent to the total registered births in Mountain Province. This means that about 2 in every 10 births in the province were listed in the municipality.



About Two in Every Ten Illegitimate Births are Registered in Bontoc

Of the 1,407 illegitimate births registered in Mountain Province in 2022, 291 births or 20.68 percent of the total were registered in Bontoc. This means that about 2 in every 10 babies registered in the province in 2022 who were born out of wedlock were listed in this municipality.

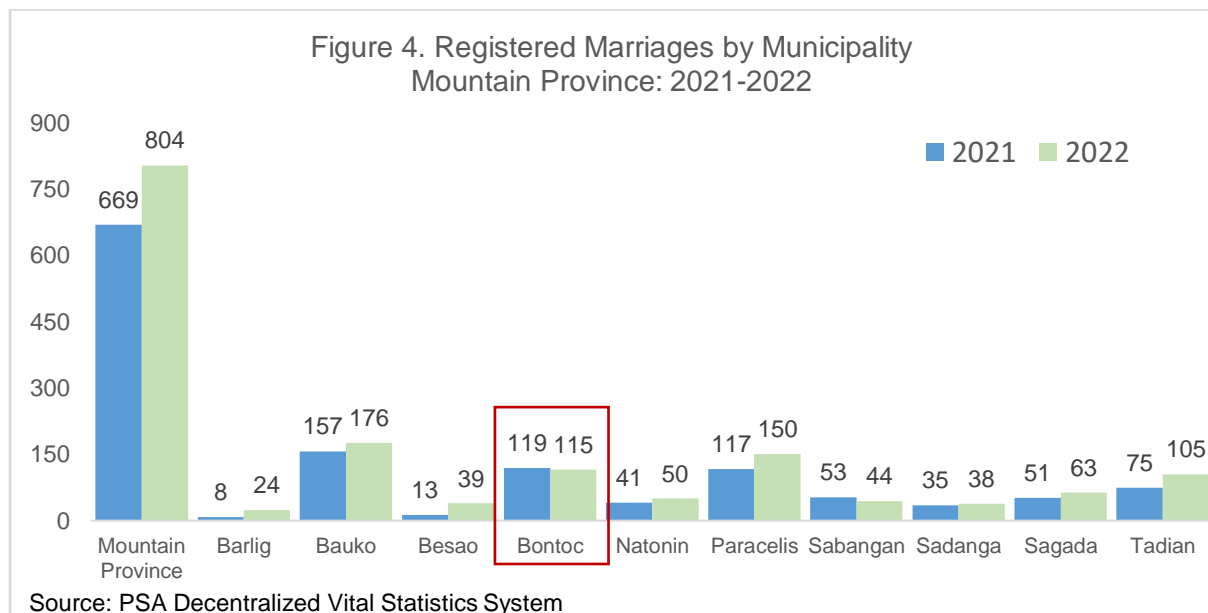


Live Birth is the complete expulsion or extraction of a product of conception from its mother, irrespective of the duration of pregnancy, which after such separation, breathes or shows any other evidence of life, such as beating of the heart, pulsation of the umbilical cord, or definite movement of voluntary muscles, whether the umbilical cord has been cut off or the placenta is still attached.

About One in Every Ten Marriages in the Province is Recorded in Bontoc

According to records by municipality, Bontoc listed a total of 115 marriages in 2022. It contributed 14.30 percent to the total registered marriages in the province. This means that about 1 in every 10 marriages recorded in 2022 in Mountain Province was from this municipality. In 2021, Bontoc listed 119 marriages which was 17.89 percent of the total marriages recorded in the province.

Bontoc's record of 115 marriages in 2022 was 3.48 percent lower compared to the weddings it registered in 2021 at 119 marriages.

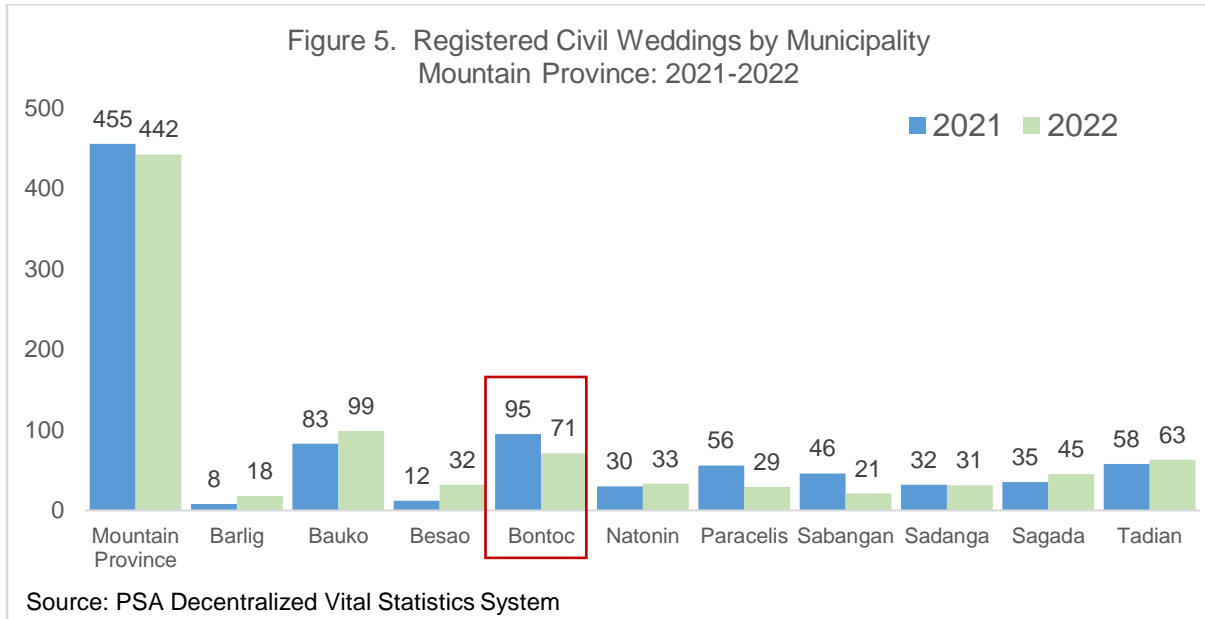


About Two in Every Ten Civil Marriages in the Province are from Bontoc

By type of ceremony, 442 or 54.98 percent of the total marriages in the province were civil weddings. This means that about 5 in every 10 marriages registered this year were civil weddings.

Of these 442 civil weddings, 71 or 16.06 percent were recorded in Bontoc which only means that about 2 in every 10 civil marriages in the province were from this municipality.

In addition, 61.74 percent of the total marriages in Bontoc were civil marriages. This means that about 6 in every 10 marriages in the municipality were civil weddings. The remaining percentages were solemnized by the Roman Catholic Church or other religious rites.

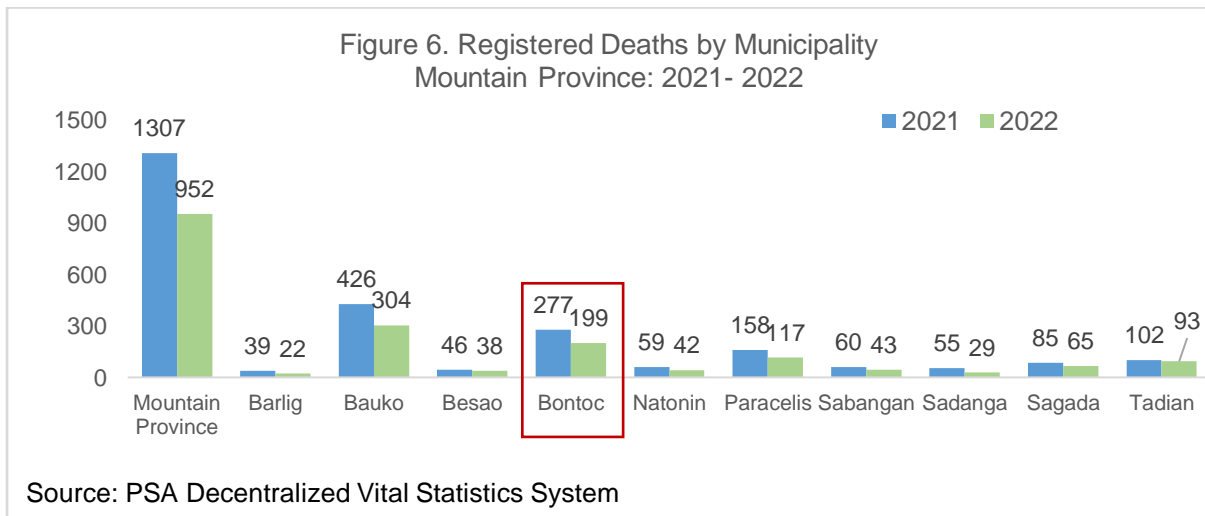


Marriage is a special contract of permanent union between a man and a woman entered into in accordance with law for the establishment of conjugal and family life.

About Two in Every Ten Deaths in the Province are Registered in Bontoc

According to records by municipality, Bontoc recorded 199 deaths for the year or 20.90 percent of the total deaths listed in the province. This means that about 2 in every 10 deaths in Mountain Province were recorded in this municipality. In 2021, Bontoc recorded a total of 277 deaths.

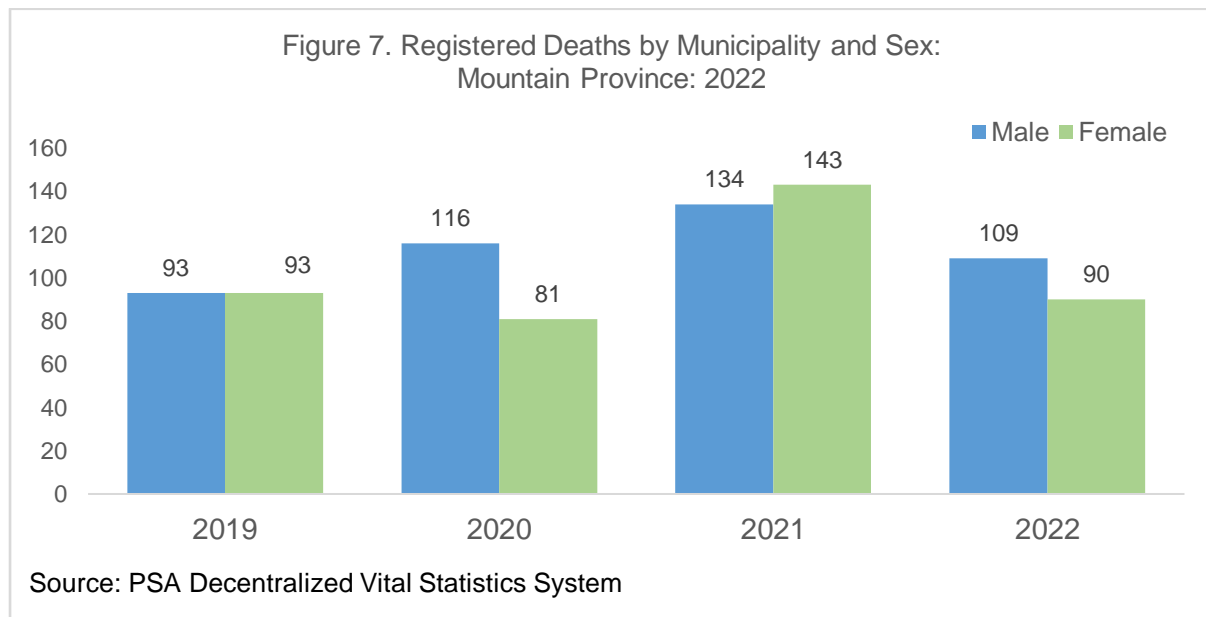
The 199 deaths registered this year in Bontoc was 28.16 percent lower than the recorded deaths it registered in 2021 at 277.



About 55 in Every 100 Deaths in Bontoc are Males

Of the 199 deaths registered in Bontoc in 2022, 109 or 54.77 percent were males. This means that about 55 in every 100 deaths were males. Same trend was observed in 2020. 2021 recorded the opposite trend while 2019 had the same number of male and female deaths.

2021 had the highest number of male deaths at 143 while the least number of deaths was recorded in 2020 at 81 male deaths.




About Four in Every Ten Deaths are Married

According to marital status of the dead, 81 or 40.70 percent were married. This only means that 4 in every 10 deaths in the municipality were married; 33.67 were widowed/ widower and 25.63 percent were single.

Categorizing by sex, 54.13 percent of the male deaths were married. This translates to about 5 in every ten male deaths were married. 30.28 percent were single and 15.59 percent were widower.

For female deaths, 55.56 percent were widow; 24.44 percent were married and 20 percent were single.

Death is the permanent disappearance of all evidence of life at any time after live births has taken place (postnatal cessation of vital functions without capability of resuscitation)
