On April 22, personnel from the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Apayao and the Provincial

Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) jointly conducted the celebration of the 55th World Earth Day with the theme, "Our Power, Our Planet". The event was participated in by Saint Paul University of the Philippines ChildFund, and the Barangay Officials of Quirino and San Isidro Sur.

The activity began with a short program, which included the Information Awareness Campaign (IAC) and a briefing. In his message, Mr. Paul Apilis, the Provincial Environment Management (PEM) Officer, emphasized the importance of not littering and proper disposal of waste. He noted that these are among the simplest yet most impactful actions of individuals in caring for the environment. All other agencies/organizations also imparted their messages focused on environment.

Following the program, a cleanup drive was conducted. Participants collected trash starting from the Quirino Barangay Hall, passing through the public market, and ending at the San Isidro Sur Barangay Hall. A total of 40 kilograms of waste was collected—22 kilograms of residual waste and 18 kilograms of recyclables.
