#### 35TH CIVIL REGISTRATION MONTH

Philippine Statistics Authority-Ifugao officially launch the 35th Civil Registration Month on February 3, 2025, by staging a motorcade from Lagawe to Lamut, Ifugao. Following the motorcade is a tree planting, conducted at Sanafe, Lamut, Ifugao in coordination with the DENR-Ifugao, which provided 60 seedlings of "Malasantol" to be planted. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 682 dated January 28, 1991 by President Corazon A. Aquino, the entire month of February is Civil Registration Month. The proclamation was meant to remind every Filipino of their obligation to register vital events in their lives such as birth, marriage, and death, as well as decrees, legal instruments, or judicial orders which may alter their civil status.

PSA-Ifugao, in collaboration with the Association of Ifugao Municipal Civil Registrars (AIMCR), kicked off a Fun Walk on February 5, 2025, with a streamer that highlighted the theme of the 35th Civil Registration Month, which is: "Building a Resilient, Agile, and Future-fit Civil Registration and Vital Statistics System." The participants of the Fun Walk started at the PSA Office and walked to the West Playground Fitness Gym, for a Zumba workout. After the Zumba, the participants walked back to the PSA Office, where Pastor Ronald B. Godoy led a Spiritual Upliftment Session on "How to Run Our Christian Faith." The PSA employees and the members of the Association of Ifugao Municipal Civil Registrars ended the day by participating in a Civil Registration Month Quiz Bee.

## VALIDATION AND AUTHENTICATION OF SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS/IDS

As part of Civil Registration Month, PSA-Ifugao held a blended training on February 24, 2025, for Civil Registry System Outlets and PhilSys Registration Centers. Led by RO I Christine Mae U. Cariño, who had other PSA-Ifugao staff and PhilSys field staff in attendance, the session covered the history of PhilSys, National ID security features, and Civil Registration Services. Participants also learned to determine the authenticity of various IDs and documents. The training aimed to enhance identity verification through technology.


#### **FEBRUARY 2025 LFS 3RD LEVEL TRAINING**

information pertaining to the demographic and socio-economic attributes of people residing in the Philippines which is done on a national scope through households on a quarterly as well as monthly basis.



# HOW TO GENERATE YOUR DIGITAL NATIONAL ID 1 Open your internet browser and type in the website https://national-id.gov.ph 2 Click the "Proceed" button to provide "Consent" to PSA to use your demographic information and facial image to authenticate. 3 In the designated fields, type your First Name, Middle Name, Last Name, and your Date of Birth. 4 Scroll down and click the "Continue" button. 5 Click on the "Start Liveness" button to begin the facial authentication. 6 Once verified, you can now proceed to view your Digital National ID by clicking on the "View National ID" button. 7 Click on the "Download Digital ID" button to obtain a personal copy of your Digital National ID. THE DIGITAL NATIONAL ID IS NOW ACCEPTED as a valid and sufficient proof of identity, subject to authentication with government, financial, and private institution transactions.
