PSA-ABRA MARKS ANOTHER MILESTONE AS IT SUCCESSFULLY REGISTERED 200,000 ABREÑOS TO PHILSYS BY THE END OF JUNE 2024

Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Abra Provincial Statistical Office (PSO) - PhilSys Registry Office (PRO) has reached a milestone of 79.78% registration rate based on the 2020 Census of Population and Housing (CPH), resulting in a total of 200,225 Abreño registrants as of June 30, 2024. This significant success is the result of the tireless efforts and strategic preparation of the PhilSys Registry Team (PRT) under the leadership of Chief Statistical Specialist (CSS) Felixberto B. Perdido and supervision of PhilSys Focal Person (PFP) Jonnel P. Aveño., and collaborative effort with various relying parties such as local government units (LGUs)... *CONTINUATION....pg.2*

and its barangay local government units (BLGUs), national government agencies (NGAs), and community service organizations (CSOs). One of the key strategies implemented by the team was the inclusion of children below five years old in the registration process. Recognizing the importance of early registration, they ensured that even the youngest members of the community were registered. This effort was facilitated by targeted campaigns at daycare centers, where there was a high concentration of potential registrants. By focusing on these centers, the team could efficiently register large groups of

children, contributing significantly to the overall registration numbers. Furthermore, the team employed continuous centralized mobile registrations and house-to-house mobile registration to reach remote and underserved areas. These mobile units were essential in ensuring that residents who could not visit the fixed registration centers due to geographical or logistical challenges were still able to register for their National IDs. The mobile registration units traveled to various locations, providing convenient and accessible registration services to the community. In addition to these efforts, the team also participated in extensive community outreach and awareness programs and caravans. They conducted mobile registration during these activities and information campaigns to educate the public about the importance of the National ID and the registration process. These initiatives

PROVINCIAL CBMS COORDINATING BOARD CONVENES TO PREPARE FOR 2024 POPCEN-CBMS ROLLOUT







The Provincial POPCEN-CBMS Coordinating Boards convened on June 5, 2024 at PSA-Abra Data Processing Room to prepare for the 2024 Census of Population and Community-Based Monitoring System (POPCEN-CBMS) roll-out this year. The convening of the PCCB was successfully undertaken in collaboration with the Provincial Governor of the Provincial Government of Abra (PGA) who served as chairperson of the PCCB through the Provincial **Planning** and Development Coordinators (PPDC). Present during the activity were Chief Statistical Specialist (CSS) Felixberto B. Perdido, CBMS Focal Person and Senior Statistical Specialist Ludivina S. Beñas. Information Systems Analyst II Zaniatha B. Rigor, DILG LGOO VI Jaleenar Andanan-Teneza and LGOO V Mark Anthony Balanay, representatives from various offices of the PGA, Abra Provincial Police Office, DepEd, ASIST, DTI, and PHO.

The PSA representatives discussed the overview, objectives, scope, legal bases, data privacy, and confidentiality of information for the 2024 POPCEN-CBMS. They also addressed the roles and responsibilities of PCCB members during the convening. The board assured that they would provide any necessary assistance for the 2024 POPCEN-CBMS rollout. Members asked questions and sought clarifications to mitigate potential risks or problems and ensure smooth POPCEN-CBMS operations.

PROVINCIAL CBMS COORDINATING BOARDS CONVENE TO PREPARE FOR 2024 POPCEN-CBMS ROLLOUT

The Philippine Statistics Authority will facilitate the conduct of the 2024 Census of Population and Community-Based Monitoring System (POPCEN-CBMS) in July 2024. These statistical activities are based on Republic Act No 10625 the Philippine Statistical Act of 2013 and RA No 11315 or the CBMS Act of 2019. In connection with this, PSA Abra conducted a six-day Provincial Level Training (PLT) on the 2024 POPCEN-CBMS Household Data Collection and Geotagging from 17 to 22 June 2024 at Provincial Government of Abra Multi-Purpose Social Hall. The training was participated by PSO Abra Personnel headed by Chief Statistical Specialist Felixberto B. Perdido and 28 hired Census CBMS Area Supervisors. The participants will serve as trainers in the Municipal Level Trainings. Through this simultaneous undertaking, the PSA will be in able to adhere to its mandate updating the population of the country ensuring the updating of social registries of national government agencies and local evidence-based government units project development and program implementation.





PSA ABRA CONDUCTS THE 2023 HOUSEHOLD ENERGY CONSUMPTION SURVEY (HECS)

The 2023 HECS is a joint statistical activity by the PSA nd Department of Energy (DOE) from 17 June to 19 July 2024 which aims to gather information on households' utilization of fueks, supply systems, patterns of energy use, and other indicators that will be useful to assess the curremy energy profile of different households and communities in the country.

PSA-ABRA EXPANDS PHILSYS SERVICES, SUCCESSFULLY LAUNCHESTHE UPDATING OF DEMOGRAPHIC INFORMATION IN THE PHILIPPINE ID

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Abra Provincial Statistical Office successfully launched the full-scale implementation of change correction of entry/ies in the demographic information of the registered person on 17 June 2024 at the PhilSys Fixed Registration Center, PSA-Abra, DZPA Bldg., Rizal St., Zone 6, Bangued, Abra. This is in accordance with Section 11 of Republic Act (RA) No. 11055, otherwise known as the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) Act, that the registered individuals are required to update their registration information in case of change in or correction of entry/entries in the information collected and stored under the PhilSys. The updating and correction services will reflect the updates and correct the errors in the PhilSysregistered records of individuals. These services highlight the commitment of PhilSys in ensuring the reliability and efficiency of the National ID system. Abreños can now avail of the updating and correction services for various personal information fields, including correcting misspelled name, rectifying incorrect date of birth, updating place of birth, confirming blood type, adjusting gender information, changing address, and updating marital status.

Updating services will be provided free of charge and available at designated PhilSys fixed registration centers across the country. The registered person is advised to personally appear at the designated PhilSys FRC in the province to process his/her request. The registered person must be in possession of his/her Philippine Identification (PhilID), ePhilID, or digital National ID. The registered person shall duly accomplish the PhilSys Form No. 2 and present the documents needed.
