CRS MOBILE REGISTRATION SERVICE

In line with the celebration of the 2025 Gotad ad Ifugao Festival, the Ifugao Provincial Statistical Office, in partnership with the PSA Regional Statistical Services Office - Cordillera Administrative Region (RSSO-CAR), conducted a three-day Mobile Registration and SECPA Issuance Drive. This outreach initiative brought civil registration services closer to the community, making it more convenient for residents to access essential documents and register for the National Identification System. Clients were able to request Certificates of Live Birth, Marriage, Death, and Certificates of No Marriage Record (CENOMAR). Many also completed their registration for the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys). To the satisfaction of the clients, requested civil registry documents were issued on the spot.

Registration was scheduled at two sites:

- June 17–18: New Multipurpose Building, Provincial Capitol Compound
- June 19: New LMDC Building, PSA - Ifugao Provincial Office

Working under the leadership of the PSA - Ifugao Provincial Statistical Office and with valuable assistance from the Regional Office, particularly ADAS II Julie B. Wacolin and AA IV - COSW Janice B. Pootan, the team served a total of 230 clients during the drive – 78 on the first day, 67 on the second, and 85 on the final day.

REGIONAL CYBERSECURITY ASSESSMENT

On 25 June 2025, the PSA - Ifugao Office moved closer to stronger data protection by participating in the Regional Cybersecurity Assessment held at its site in the New LMDC Building, Poblacion West, Lagawe. This initiative supports the ongoing preparation for ISO 27001 Information Security Management System (ISMS) certification and reaffirms the agency's broader commitment to enhanced cybersecurity.



The on-site review was led by three specialists from the PSA Central Office: Information Systems Analysts Hazel B. Solivio and Louie Andrew G. Florendo, along with Computer Maintenance Technologist Fidel Rosstum L. Viguilla. Over the course of the day, they toured the facility to evaluate compliance with established data privacy policies and technical security standards.

PSO - Ifugao technical team Registration Office I representative Christine Mae U. Carino, Information System Analyst Lalaine T. Baguilat and Yang Shi Mae G. Wangag prepared the required assessment documentation and fielded questions raised by the visitors.

Later that afternoon, the Central Office assessors presented their preliminary observations in a feedback session that included an open dialogue. They offered practical steps the local team could take immediately to further strengthen the Office cyber defenses.

JUNE TRAININGS CONDUCTED

The Ifugao Provincial Statistical Office conducted three separate trainings in June 2025. The purpose was to provide the required skill sets to the Statistical Researchers with regard to data gathering, as well as other technical processes. The following were conducted:

Livestock and Poultry Survey: Establishment and Household



In preparation for the Livestock and Poultry Survey: Establishment (LPS:E) and the Livestock and Poultry Survey: Household (LPS:H), Statistical Specialist II Eric B. Aplosen conducted a training session with three newly hired Statistical Researchers on 16-17 June 2025 at Lagawe, Ifugao

The LPS: E seeks to generate estimates on the supply and disposition of livestock and poultry commodities from sample establishments. On the other hand, the LPS: H aims to generate estimates on the supply and disposition of livestock and poultry commodities at the household level.

Quarterly Aquaculture & Quarterly Inland Fishing Survey



On 19 June 2025, SS II Eric B. Aplosen led a training for three newly hired Statistical Researchers. The session covered two important surveys: the Quarterly Aquaculture Survey (QAqS) and the Quarterly Inland Fisheries Survey (QIFS).

The main goal of the QAqS is to collect data on how much and what kind of aquaculture products are being produced, including the type of fish, the kind of farm, and the value of the harvest. For QIFS, it's almost the same, but this one focuses on inland fishing. Both surveys help us understand how our fisheries sector is doing in Ifugao.

Rice and Corn Stocks Survey and the Palay Production Survey and Corn Production Survey



The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) – Ifugao conducted a one-day training on the Rice and Corn Stocks Survey (RCSS), Palay Production Survey (PPS), and Corn Production Survey (CPS) on 27 June 2025 at the New LMDC Building in Lagawe, Ifugao. The training was led by SA Gavino A. Mongalini, Jr. to equip the five hired Statistical Researchers with the knowledge and skills needed to gather accurate and reliable data.

The RCSS is conducted monthly to monitor rice and corn stock levels, while the PPS and CPS are done quarterly to estimate production, yield, and the area harvested for palay and corn in the province.

HOW TO GENERATE YOUR DIGITAL NATIONAL ID

- 1 Open your internet browser and type in the website <https://national-id.gov.ph>
- 2 Click the "Proceed" button to provide "Consent" to PSA to use your demographic information and facial image to authenticate.
- 3 In the designated fields, type your **First Name, Middle Name, Last Name, and your Date of Birth.**
- 4 Scroll down and click the "Continue" button.
- 5 Click on the "Start Liveness" button to begin the facial authentication.
- 6 Once verified, you can now proceed to view your Digital National ID by clicking on the "View National ID" button.
- 7 Click on the "Download Digital ID" button to obtain a personal copy of your Digital National ID.
