#### **Provincial Product Accounts (PPA)**

The Briefing/Workshop with Stakeholders of CAR on the Provincial Products Account (PPA) was attended by CSS Imelda L. Buyuccan and COSW SA Diana Joy P. Nabor on October 4-5, 2021 via zoom. The activity aimed to 1) brief the participants/stakeholders on the System of National Accounts (SNA); 2) discuss the importance of the PPA and the data requirements for the compilation of PPA; and 3) gather feedback on the perception of participants on the economic situation of the region and its provinces.

#### 2021 Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS)

The second level training for the 2021 Global Adult Tobacco Survey (GATS) conducted at the Plaza Lodge, South Drive, Baguio City was participated by SS II Nalyn C. Esican and SA Sheila Mae Barcena, 5 Teams Supervisors and 22 Enumerators on October 25-30, 2021.

The 2021 Global Adult Tobacco Survey is a nationally representative household survey of adults 15 year of age or older designed to systematically monitor adult tobacco use. The 2021 GATS aims to gather information on adult tobacco use (smoking and smokeless) and key tobacco control indicators across Specifically, it intends to provide countries. estimates of tobacco use, exposure to secondhand smoking, quit attempts, and other key tobacco control indicators at the urban/ rural level. For PSA-Benguet Provincial Statistical Office, there were 22 Field Interviewers and five Team Supervisors to visit the 2,062 sample households in Baguio City and 98 sample households in Benguet.



# Community Based Monitoring System (CBMS)

The Pilot CBMS City Level Training conducted at the Baguio City Batch 1 was National High School on October 4-8, 2021. PSA-Benguet Provincial Office personnel headed by CSS Imelda L. Buyuccan assisted personnel of LGU Baguio during the training of the Team Supervisors Enumerators, Personnel from PSA Central Office also assisted during the said training. The training was continued on October 11-15, 2021. Mock interview and hands-on training Computer Assisted Interview (CAPI) for the were undertaken.

Moreover, PSA-Central Office and Benguet Provincial Office personnel had their courtesy call at the City Mayor's Office on October 18, 2021 for the conduct of the data collection of the 2021 CBMS at Baguio City. Supervision and courtesy call to the Barangay Chairperson and official were done on October 21, 2021 for the roll-out of the two barangays in Baguio City (Asin Road and Irisan).

Also, the Memorandum of Agreement for the 2021 Pilot CBMS was conducted on October 25, 2021 at City Hall, Baguio City.



ψ Baguio City's total population increase at 26,690 persons in 2015

• The population of Baguio City as of August 1, 2015 was 345,366 based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). This was higher by 26,690 persons over the 2010 census figure of 318,676, and by 92,980 persons compared with the population of 252,386 in 2000.

#### ψ Baguio City's population growth rate at 1.54 percent

The annual population growth rate (PGR) of Baguio City for the period of 2010 to 2015 is 1.54 percent, from a 2.36 percent PGR recorded for the period of 2000-2010. This means that there were approximately two persons added per year for every 100 persons in the population.

ψ Total population of Benguet increase at 42.3 thousand

Benguet posted a total population of 446,224 persons as of August 1, 2015 based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN 2015). This was higher by 42,280 persons over the 2010 census figure of 403,944, and by 116,095 persons com-pared with the population of 330,129 in 2000.
