Municipal CBMS Coordinating Boards Convene to
prepare for 2024 CBMS rollout

Three (3) Municipal CBMS Coordinating Boards convened in February 2024 to prepare for the 2024 Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) roll-out this year. The convening of the MCCBs was successfully undertaken in collaboration with Local Chief Executives (LCEs) of the Local Government Units (LGUs) who served as chairpersons of the MCCB through the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinators (MPDCs). CBMS Provincial Focal Person, Senior Statistical Specialist Ludivina S. Beñas and other PSO personnel, served as co-chairpersons of the MCCBs. The municipalities that convened the MCCBs were San Quintin, Malibcong, and Tayum. The MCCB of San Quintin was held at Municipal Hall, Poblacion, San Quintin on February 1, Malibcong at Presidencia Malibcong, Umap, Malibcong on February 12, and Tayum at Municipal Session Hall, Poblacion, Tayum, Abra on February 20, 2024.

The PSA representatives discussed the overview, objectives, scope, legal bases, data privacy, and confidentiality of information for the 2024 CBMS. They also addressed the roles and responsibilities of MCCB members during the convening. The LGUs assured that they would provide any necessary assistance for the 2024 CBMS rollout. Members asked questions and sought clarifications to mitigate potential risks or problems and ensure smooth CBMS operations.

2,222 Individuals Registered, 921 ePhilIDs Issued in February 2024

PSA-Abra PhilSys Registry Team (PRT) continued the PhilSys Step 2 Registration process and exerted all efforts to register the remaining unregistered individuals. In February 2024, the PSA-Abra PRT successfully registered 2,222 individuals and issued 921 ePhilIDs in February 2024. PhilSys Focal Person (PFP) Jonnel P. Aveño and Information Officer I (IO I) Angelee Ann B. Perez also conducted Information, Education, and Communication (IEC) campaign to enhance public awareness of PhilSys

at Caganayan, Tineg, Abra on February 1, 2024. Additionally, PhilSys opened registration for children aged one (1) to four (4) years old, with the Abra PRT commencing on February 13, 2024, and registering 361 children within that age range. These various strategies aimed to increase the daily average output of the entire PhilSys team, resulting in a 39.60 percent increase in the number of registered individuals in February 2024 compared to January 2024.

The PSA-Abra Provincial Statistical Office PhilSys Registry Team (PRT) participated in the Medical Dental Outreach Program conducted by the PNP 2nd PMFC on February 14, 2024 at Sitio Batbato, Kinabiti, Pilar, Abra and provided PhilSys mobile registration services. The team registered 15 individuals during the activity. The PRT's participation in this event brings services closer to the people.

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) has continued to collaborate with the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) to accommodate Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (4Ps) beneficiaries to Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) registration and other identification services. The Abra PRT conducted this co-location activity in DSWD's Family Development Sessions (FDS) in February 2024 at municipalities of Tayum, Danglas, and Lagayan.



2023 Family Income and Expenditure Survey (FIES)- Visit 2 Data Processing



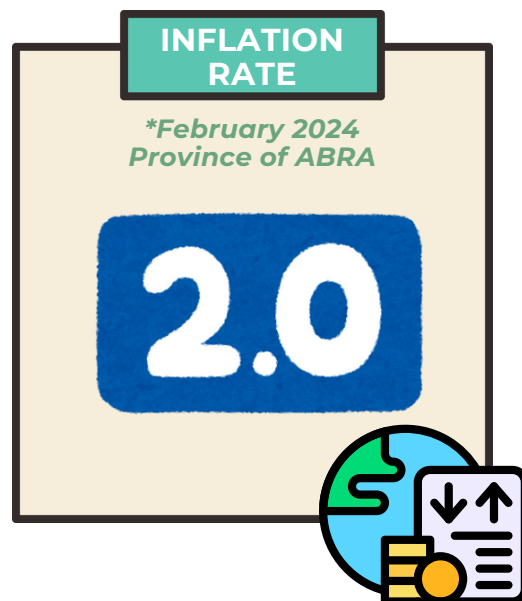

2023 National Information and Communications Technology Household Survey



PSA Abra conducted the 2023 National Information and Communications Technology Survey (NICTHS) on February 5 to March 4, 2024. The 2023 NICTHS aims to gather updated household and individual Information and Communications Technology (ICT) data that are necessary for producing internationally comparable core ICT indicators. The data gathered will also serve as a valuable input in monitoring existing programs, development projects and formulation of future policies geared towards the advancement of ICT in the country.
