The 2024 Annual Survey of Philippine Business and Industry (ASPBI) and 2024 Survey on Communications and Technology (SICT) Third Level Training was conducted last April 7-8 and 10-11, 2025 at PSA-Benguet Conference Hall. This was participated by the different hired statistical researchers. The 2024 ASPBI and 2024 SICT distribution of questionnaire will commence on April 21, 2025.



The Second Level Training on the May 2025 Labor Force Survey (LFS) with Rider Questions on Volunteer Work Questions was conducted on April 22-25, 2025 at Prince Plaza Hotel, Legarda Rd., Baguio City. LFS is a monthly/quarterly household survey that tracks the Philippine labor market, generating key employment indicators. This round aims to assess the pandemic's ongoing impact on labor and employment. The Volunteer Work Questions module, added to the LFS, seeks to provide reliable data on volunteerism's economic potential, informing policy makers and program managers in crafting civic engagement opportunities and guidelines.
