CONVERSION OF THE COMMUNITY-BASED MONITORING SYSTEM (CBMS) TECHNICAL COMMITTEE INTO CBMS TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP WITH UPDATED COMPOSITION AND TERMS OF REFERENCE

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11315 otherwise known as Community-Based Monitoring System Act (CBMS Act) was enacted on 17 April 2019, institutionalizing the conduct of the Community-Based Monitoring System (CBMS) in every city and municipality in the country;

WHEREAS, Section 14 provides for the creation of the CBMS Council composed of the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), and Department of Information and Communications Technology (DICT), to be headed by the PSA, for purposes of achieving secure and efficient data sharing arrangements between and among concerned cities and municipalities and national government agencies to be used for their particular social protection and welfare programs and projects;

WHEREAS, the CBMS Council, in its Resolution No. 06, Series of 2021, approved the establishment of the Provincial and City/Municipal CBMS Coordinating Boards;

WHEREAS, the Committee deemed it necessary to establish a technical committee that shall be responsible for overseeing and ensuring the smooth flow of CBMS operations in the region;

WHEREAS, through RSC-CAR Resolution No. 05, series of 2022, signed on 18 March 2022, the CBMS Technical Committee was created with the following composition and terms of reference;
