**ENJOINING ALL REGIONAL LINE AGENCIES, LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS,
ACADEMES, AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR TO SUPPORT AND ACTIVELY
PARTICIPATE IN THE 33RD NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH (NSM) CELEBRATION
AND THE 15TH NATIONAL CONVENTION ON STATISTICS (NCS)**

WHEREAS, the annual celebration of the National Statistics Month (NSM) is pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647 issued on 20 September 1990 by then President Corazon C. Aquino declaring the month of October of every year as the National Statistics Month to enhance awareness and appreciation of the value and importance of statistics to the different sectors of society;

WHEREAS, coinciding with the 33rd NSM celebration in October 2022 is the conduct of the 15th National Convention on Statistics (NCS) which is conducted every three years by the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) by virtue of the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Board Resolution No. 01, Series of 2017 - 073 "Approving the Conduct of the National Convention on Statistics Every Three Years";

WHEREAS, the NCS aims to: a.) provide a forum for exchanging ideas and experiences in the field of statistics and for discussing recent statistical developments and prevailing issues and problems of the PSS; and b.) elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system;

WHEREAS, the 33rd NSM and the 15th NCS carry the theme, "*Boosting the Country's Recovery with Informed Decisions, Better Policies*", which focuses on the role of quality statistics as an instrument to better-informed policy and decision making, and formulating initiatives toward inclusive economic recovery;

WHEREAS, statisticians, statistical practitioners, researchers, members of the academe, students, representatives from the media, and other partners from both the government and private sectors are encouraged to submit and present papers in the 15th NCS to be held in Crowne Plaza Manila Galleria in Ortigas Ave. cor. Asian Development Bank Ave., Quezon City on 03-05 October 2022;

WHEREAS, paper presenters shall accomplish and submit application forms, abstract and final manuscript of papers by accomplishing Bulletin No. 1: Call for Papers for the 15th National Convention on Statistics which forms part of this Resolution;

WHEREAS, the public and private agencies are likewise encouraged to conduct virtual, face-to-face, or hybrid activities in support of the 33rd NSM for the whole month of October 2022 following the established public health and safety measures against COVID-19. These activities may be in the form of symposia, workshops, orientation seminars, exhibits, slide shows, and publication of statistical reports, indicators, and other relevant information in

accordance with the capabilities of the participating agencies and organizations, and to display/hang the NSM streamer and NCS posters in office building facades and/or posting of the digital poster of the NSM on their official websites, Facebook Pages and social media accounts;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly seconded, BE IT:


RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the RSC-CAR enjoins all public and private agencies in the Cordillera Administrative Region to support and actively participate in the 33rd NSM celebration and 15th NCS this October 2022;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the different government agencies, local government units (LGUs), and the private sector enroll NSM activities by accomplishing PSA-NSM Form 1: Call for 33rd NSM Activities and submit to the RSC-CAR/PSA-NSM Secretariat by 30 July 2022 for consolidation to become the 2022 NSM Regional Calendar of Activities;


RESOLVED FINALLY, that the agencies, LGUs, and institutions shall furnish the RSC-CAR through the PSA-CAR as RSC Secretariat with reports on the conducted NSM activities on or before 15 November 2022 for documentation.

The Philippine Statistical System (PSS) through the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) invites interested paper writers/presenters to the **15th National Convention on Statistics (NCS)** on **03-05 October 2022** at the Crowne Plaza Manila Galleria in Ortigas Ave. cor. Asian Development Bank Ave., Quezon City.

About the Convention

The NCS, organized by the PSS and spearheaded by the PSA, is conducted every three years and aims to:

- 1) provide a forum for practitioners and theoreticians in the field of statistics to discuss prevailing issues and emerging developments affecting the PSS; and
- 2) elicit the cooperation and support of statisticians and professionals in related fields from the government, academe and private sector towards a more responsive statistical system.

This year, the 15th NCS will feature plenary sessions, invited/contributed paper sessions, poster sessions, panel discussions, statistical trainings, and the Statistical Information Management Exhibit (SIMEx).

The Opening Ceremony of the NCS will coincide with the 33rd National Statistics Month (NSM) Opening Ceremony on 03 October 2022.

Requirements for Proposed Papers

Interested paper writers on any topics covered by the 15th NCS must submit the **title of the paper** together with the **abstract** and **accomplished information sheet** (attached and can be downloaded at the NCS website <https://www.psa.gov.ph/ncs/15th/downloads> on or before **27 June 2022** to the 15th NCS Secretariat/PSA Central and/or Regional Offices at the addresses indicated in this bulletin. Submission of requirements may be through fax, e-mail, courier, or may be hand-carried.

Abstract for papers must not exceed two hundred (200) words, with Arial font and size of 11 points. It must also be typed double-spaced on standard A4 paper with 1" margin on all sides.

ACCEPTANCE OF SUBMITTED PAPERS

From the submitted paper abstracts, papers for presentation during the Convention will be chosen by the Session Organizers. In the review of the papers to be presented, the following criteria shall be considered:

- relevance of the paper to the overall objectives of the convention;
- timeliness of the topic of the paper vis-à-vis current and emerging concerns of the PSS; and
- impact on the demands and requirements of data users and other stakeholders in the PSS. Papers which have been presented in other fora, local or international, may be accepted if revisions can be made in the paper to include updates.

Authors of accepted papers will be notified on or before **15 July 2022**. Final manuscripts should not exceed 5,000 words, single-spaced and using Arial font size of 11 points. The final manuscript must be submitted not later than **15 August 2022** to the designated focal persons of the NCS Secretariat in the PSA Central Office, Luzon, Visayas and Mindanao. All materials must be written and presented in English.

All papers accepted and received on or before **15 August 2022** will be included in the 15th NCS publication to be disseminated during the first day of the 15th NCS.

Invited Paper Sessions

About 60 invited papers will be presented during the 15th NCS that will be conducted simultaneously in various meeting rooms, with each session discussing two papers. The presentation of each invited paper will be allotted 15 to 20 minutes and the discussant will be given 10 minutes to present his/her discussion paper. Under the guidance of a moderator, a 25-minute open forum will ensue. The participants can attend their preferred sessions.

Contributed Paper Sessions

About five (5) sessions will be organized for contributed papers discussing the topics/areas of the 15th NCS. Submissions on other topics are also welcome in this session. Acceptance of contributed papers, except those invited by session organizers, will also consider the overall objectives of the convention. Three (3) papers will be presented per session with about 25 minutes allotted for open forum.
