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### FOREWORD

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) releases the 2018 to 2022 Provincial Product Accounts (PPA) of 82 provinces and 17 Highly Urbanized Cities (HUCs) in the Philippines.

The PPA serves as the mechanism of the PSA to measure the performance of the economy of the provinces and HUCs. Aligned with the National and Regional Accounts of the Philippines, the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of the provinces and HUCs are compiled at the production side. Since 2021, the GDP of the provinces and HUCs are compiled and released annually for selected pilot regions and presented by province and HUC, and by industry. These are valued at current prices and constant 2018 prices.

Spearheaded by the Macroeconomic Accounts Service and in coordination with the Regional and Provincial Statistics Offices, the compilation of PPA is implemented in 16 regions in 2023, except for the National Capital Region, which is scheduled for pilot implementation in 2024. By 2025, the PPA is programmed to be institutionalized to ensure annual compilation for all provinces and HUCs.

The PSA would like to acknowledge the support of different government agencies, local government units, and private sector in providing data and information for the compilation of PPA. We hoped that these statistics on the performance of provincial economies would guide our stakeholders for an evidence-based policies, programs, and projects, especially at the local level.

We welcome comments and suggestions from our data users, clients, and stakeholders for the improvement of this report.

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### **OVERVIEW OF PROVINCIAL PRODUCT ACCOUNTS**

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), which is the central statistical authority of the Philippine government, is primarily responsible for all national censuses and surveys, sectoral statistics, consolidation of selected administrative recording systems, and compilation of national accounts. This mandate of the PSA is stipulated in Section 5 of the Republic Act No. 10625, otherwise known as the Philippine Statistical Act of 2013.

The Macroeconomic Accounts Service (MAS) under the PSA is responsible for developing and maintaining national accounts, regional accounts, satellite accounts, input/output tables, and other related macroeconomic accounts. Presently, the PSA regularly releases quarterly, and annual national accounts estimates, while annually for the regional accounts estimates. These economic accounts are widely used for policymaking, analyses, and research purposes. Evidently, the demand for subnational disaggregation of these economic accounts is increasing. This brings forward the PSA to undertake another statistical milestone – the Provincial Product Accounts (PPA).

The PPA is a mechanism to compile the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) using production approach at the subnational level. The GDP measures the value of all final goods and services produced within an economy in a given period of time. Consistent with national and regional accounts, the PPA follows the System of National Accounts framework for compiling the GDP at the subnational level. Through the PPA, the GDP of the provinces and Highly Urbanized Cities (HUCs) will be compiled, which can be used by economic planners, policymakers, and other stakeholders in assessing the performance of local economies, policy formulation and monitoring, impact analyses, among others, for an evidence-based decision making.

The PPA is planned to be institutionalized in all provinces and HUCs in the country by 2025. It commenced in 2021 with three pilot regions (MIMAROPA Region, VII, and X). Then another six pilot regions (Cordillera Administrative Region, CALABARZON, VI, VIII, XI, and XII) were onboarded in 2022. Seven pilot regions (I, II, III, V, IX, Caraga, and Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao) were added in 2023, and the National Capital Region in 2024. By 2025, it is envisioned that all provinces and HUCs in the country are already compiling their PPAs.

Recognizing the importance of PPA, the PSA Board, the highest policy-making body on statistical matters, approved a resolution titled "Enjoining Government Agencies, Local Government Units, and Private Sectors to Provide Data Support in the Generation of Provincial Product Accounts" (PSA Board Resolution No. 04 series of 2021).

Since its inception, various activities have been undertaken, including briefings and consultation workshops with stakeholders, training on standard classification systems, data collection and validation, and trainings on the SNA. Equally vital are the coordination mechanisms in place, such as the Regional Statistics Committees and Provincial Statistics Committees, which brought together major stakeholders in the regions and provinces to support the compilation of PPA.

The annual release of the PPA results for its pilot provinces and HUCs marks as a significant milestone, not only for the PSA but also for the entire Philippine Statistical System, addressing the demand of subregional accounts.

# City of Baguio posts 11.3% growth in 2022, the fastest growing economy in Cordillera




Figure 1. Annual GDP of the City of Baguio, 2019 to 2022 Levels (in Billion PhP) and Growth Rates (in Percent) at Constant 2018 Prices

The economy of the City of Baguio continued to expand by 11.3 percent in 2022. The Gross Domestic Product (GDP) of the city was estimated at PhP 155.03 billion during the said period. The GDP of the city in 2022 already surpassed the pre-pandemic level by PhP 2.2 billion. (Figure 1)

All industries of the City of Baguio grew in 2022 and the fastest growths were recorded by the following: Transportation and storage, 63.6 percent; Accommodation and food service activities, 50.6 percent; and Other services, 47.1 percent.

Baguio City's economy continued to be Services-driven, constituting 72.8 percent of the city's total economy. Meanwhile, Industry contributed 26.6 percent to the city's PhP 155.03 billion value of GDP. On the other hand, Agriculture, forestry, and fishing contributed the least, accounting for only 0.6 percent. (Table 1)


Among the 16 industries, Manufacturing contributed the largest share to the city's economy with 21.3 percent. This was followed by Wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles, with 16.3 percent share; Financial and insurance activities, with 14.3 percent share; and Real estate and ownership of dwellings, with 9.5 percent share. In 2022, the per capita GDP of the City of Baguio was estimated at PhP 420,016. This was a 10.5 percent increase compared to the previous year. The city's per capita GDP surpassed the regional per capita GDP which was estimated at PhP 183,827. Among the sub-regional economies of the Cordillera, only the City of Baguio surpassed the per capita GDP of the region. In comparison with all highly-urbanized cities (HUC) included in the compilation of the provincial product accounts for the year, Baguio City also was the highest in per capita GDP.

The City of Baguio remained the largest economy in the region, accounting for 45.9 percent of the Gross Regional Domestic Product (GRDP) in 2022. The province of Benguet followed with 23.3 percent, and Kalinga with 8.0 percent. (Figure 2)

The Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) established through Republic Act No. 10625 or The Philippine Statistical Act of 2013, is tasked, among others, to compile and maintain macroeconomic accounts and indicators, at the national and subnational level. The Provincial Product Accounts (PPA) is a mechanism to measure the economic performance of the province or HUC at a given time.

In 2022, the Cordillera Administrative Region (CAR) was one of the six additional pilot regions to implement the PPA, marking its expansion since the inception of the PPA in 2021.

At Constant 2018 Prices | As of December 2023






### Baguio City remained the biggest economy in Cordillera accounting for 45.9 % of regional GDP

With Gross Domestic Product (GDP) valued at 155.0 billion pesos, the City of Baguio recorded the highest economic output among the sub-regional economies in Cordillera. In addition, the City of Baguio reported the highest Per Capita GDP of PhP 420,016 and the third largest GDP among the PPA piloted highly urbanized cities in 2023.

### Gross Value Added,

Gross Value Added (GVA) - represents the additional value created during the production process. Operationally, it is derived by subtracting Intermediate Consumption (IC) from Gross Output (GO). GVA can be further disaggregated into returns of the factors of production, namely: compensation, consumption of fixed capital, taxes less subsides, and operating surplus.
